

## HHLT GENERAL MEETING - JUNE 16, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. Officers in attendance were Gene Schmiel, Ina Mayer, Treva Whyte, and Goldie Grandy. Ina and Joyce Mancini were given a hearty round of applause for the outstanding job they did as directors of a "Hatful of Humor." Ina and Joyce thanked all who helped in any way to make the production a success.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by Treva, in Sandy's absence. They were amended to read June 16 for the next general meeting, and approved.

The treasurer's report showed a balance of \$10,509.37. Treva also gave a synopsis of the P&L statement for a "Hatful of Humor," which showed a profit of \$1125.82. A copy of the P&L was made available for all to see what the expenses for the production were.

Goldie said she had met with Bets Knepley concerning Bets' new role as the Communications Chairperson for the LT. Bets graciously offered to undertake this role, and, of course, the Board immediately accepted her offer. Goldie will be the Liaison between the LT Board and Bets. Bets will be putting together and editing the newsletter as of September.

Ina stated that she and Bill Harrison are ready to start on the next production for the fall, "A Few Good Years." They are working on acquiring the crew. We will have a partial read-through after the July meeting. We will finish the read-through after the August 18 meeting. Auditions will be held on Friday evening, August 19, and on Saturday morning, August 20. Because the Tuesday before the play is election day, the schedule for the rehearsals is as follows: Sunday, Nov. 6, technical rehearsal; Monday, dress rehearsal; Tuesday, free; and production Wed., Thurs., and Friday. Ina gave a brief synopsis of "A Few Good Years" and had a few copies for interested persons to sign out.

Gene pointed out that M.J. Brickach will be directing in the fall of 2012, but has not yet selected a play.

Bets talked about her visions for the communications committee. She would like to have committee members, who would not necessarily serve for the entire year. Joyce Mancini will continue to write the articles for the HORN. Bets would like to have a photographer at each general meeting to get pictures for the newsletter and the website. Anyone who has information that would be interesting and/or useful to other members should submit this to Bets. She would like to obtain a LOGO for LT, and Sharon Ferguson said she would be willing to work on it. The website address will be formally announced in September. Bets will contact former directors and historians for pictures of past productions.

It was pointed out that the LT meetings are not getting onto the calendar in the HORN. Bets said she would take care of that.

Gene pointed out that Ed Prendergast is checking into rental storage space options so we can get all of the LT property into a common area and out of residents' garages and basements. Don Jewell suggested checking into POD storage

Roger delRosario talked about the Play Writing contest. Roger and his committee have come up with rules and an announcement will be in the July HORN. It will be open to the HH community, not only HHLT members. The Board had previously approved the announcement. (A copy of the article is attached to these minutes.) It is hoped we will have a winning entry that can be produced by the HHLT.

Gene is in the process of rewriting the methodology for choosing directors for future productions. The methodology we have in place now does not work well and we hope to simplify it. Some people have expressed interest in directing the spring, 2012 play.

There was a discussion of why anyone who is willing to volunteer their time to help the LT in some way also has to become a member and pay dues. It was pointed out that we are all dues-paying volunteers and most of us put in lots of time and effort.

Sandy lasiello asked if any thought had been given to when the LT picnic would be held. Betty Hitchcock, activities chair, will be obtaining volunteers for hosting this, etc.

Joyce Mancini stated we should mark our calendars for the Sunday before Thanksgiving for the annual Thanksgiving feast at her home

Ina will be looking for people to join her on the nominating committee toward the end of the year. We will have 4 positions available for next year.

The meeting adjourned at 7:42 p.m.
