General Meeting

April 25, 2013

Meeting called to order by President Walt Meyer at 7:00 PM. Absent board member was Activities Chairperson Art Moscatello. There were 31 HHLTers in attendance.

Secretary Bill Harrison report: Minutes from March approved.

Mary Glascock presented the Treasurer's report. The club treasury balance as of April 25, 2013 is \$14,965.59. Since the March report there has been income of \$5,280 from dues and ticket sales. Expenses were \$1,267.08 primarily for play expenses and the HHLT birthday party.

VP Kathryn Schmiel reported the play is going well. On Monday there will be a tech rehearsal followed by a dress rehearsal on Tuesday. On Sunday the set will be moved to the ballroom from the Schmiel's basement at 8:00 PM. Anyone who can provide a truck please let Ted Day know. Anyone who can volunteer to help move the set should also let Ted know right away. Ted Day will need some help Monday at 7:30 AM to get the set framework set up . At 9:30 AM help will be needed to start putting the fabric on. Please volunteer if possible.

Betty Hitchcock said the play was going well but there were some issues with storing props.

Helen Esposito reported the following ticket sales to date: Wednesday 122, Thursday 155 and Friday 119.

Walt informed the club that Art Moscatello had cataract surgery today. No further information was available.

Speaking for Art, Walt indicated we are planning a picnic for July of this year. It is possible we could use the Marsh Mansion or Joan Patton offered her house as a possibility.

Walt also announced that M. J. Brickach has volunteered to be the coordinator for the hospital benefit.

M. J. said we could use the current picture of the Board for the hospital benefit poster. She also said she would be looking for volunteers to do a 20 minute skit for the benefit; preferably something humorous.

Membership Chairperson Joan Patton had no new members to report. Tom Taggart, Member-at-Large had nothing to report.

New Business: Walt announced that Gene Schmiel's proposal to direct the fall production in October 2013 was approved by the board. Gene said the play will be Ancestral Voices by A. R. Gurney, the author of Love Letters; a previous HHLT readers theater production. It follows a family in Buffalo, NY from 1935 - 1960. The cast will be 4 men and 3 women and will also be in the reader theater format.
