General Meeting
May 15, 2014

Meeting called to order by President Tom Taggart at 7:00 PM. Board members absent were Helen Esposito and Jim Burwell. Also absent was Communications Director Bets Knepley. There were 25 HHLTers in attendance.

Secretary Bill Harrison's report: The minutes for April 2014 were approved.

Bill Harrison presented the Treasurer's report. The balance for the HHLT as of May 06, 2014 was \$11,430.18. There was income from dues of \$30.00 and ticket sales from the play of \$4450.00. Expenses of \$1307.99 were primarily for the Senior Follies.

Vice President Sandy Thompson stated that any ideas are welcome for revising the play review form and ideas should be e-mailed to her or communicated by phone.

Bill Harrison and Ina Mayer praised the great results from the cast and crew of Senior Follies.

Walt Meyer and Betty Hitchcock discussed their upcoming fall play - A Nice Family Gathering. This is a multi-generational play with roles for four women and four men and one female role that does not appear on stage. There will be readings at next month's meeting and auditions will be announced at that time. The play dates are October 28, 29 and 30, 2014. Jane Becker has already volunteered to be stage director. Other crew positions are still available.

M. J. Brickach, who had presented a proposal for the play The Porch, expressed her concern that her play had not been given a fair evaluation. M. J. felt the Board should have read the play. She felt the play would be very appropriate for the HH audience; although the Board had felt it would not.

President Tom Taggart reported for Kathryn Schmiel that Sandy Mills had won the Brain Teaser question for May. He also indicated the Board would be evaluating the entire play proposal process.

Membership Chairperson Joan Patton had nothing to report.

Bill Harrison reported for Member-at-Large Jim Burwell that the memorial bench with its plaque has been placed at the intersection of Charismatic and Heritage Hunt Drive.

Activities Chairperson Nancy Mahevich reported there will be refreshments for the June general meeting and we will also begin planning for an HHLT picnic in the fall.
