At Large: No report


The meeting was adjourned at 7:20 pm.



James Caan, movie and TV actor who rose to fame in *The Godfather* movies, passed away on July 6. He was 82. He is said to have adlibbed the expression "Ba-da-bing" while filming *The Godfather* in which he played Sonny Corleone. He was also revered for his acting in *Misery*, *Brian's Song* (TV movie), and *Elf* among his many movies. He was born and raised in New York City and attended the Neighborhood Playhouse School of Theater. Caan was 82.


