Activities: Kathryn volunteered to lead activities in Oct. and Nov. meetings. Tonight we will be playing Cinema Trivia in teams. Nov. will be a Readers' Theater play, "Sorry, Wrong Number". December will be our holiday party – the location will be announced

<u>Communications:</u> This month's space in The Horn was used to advertise the play. An article will appear next month about the success of the play.

At Large: Rob has been working with Ted Day who is creating a door that opens and closes for the play. Ted has a long history of leading construction for our plays. His many efforts are much appreciated. Don Jewell helped. Many thanks to you both.

Old Business: Have not been able to have whole cast at a rehearsal yet. Many have helped by reading parts to fill in. Take down of the set will be right after end of last performance. Mary Ann Lesnick has volunteered to host the cast party, which will be on November 1.

New Business: Traditionally, we have 2 plays a year – spring and fall. One play has been mentioned as a possibility but there is not yet a formal proposal. If anyone has an idea for a play or would like to find a play to direct for the spring production, contact Tom Taggart.

Priscilla Knight said she and her husband Randolph are going to do a skit for the HH holiday show on Dec. 10. She suggested since the Troubadours will not be singing, maybe we could get a group together to sing carols in the show. Sally Peterson has an idea for several humorous poems to be read. Once the play is over, Sally will work on casting readers for the holiday show.

The next general meeting of HHLT will be Nov. 15, 2024, at Marsh Mansion 7 p.m.
